Fostering Excellence Research in Outermost Regions: Background

Article 349 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union (TFEU) recognises that:

"Outermost Regions differ from the rest of the EU in a number of ways that constrain their economic and social development" such as:

- their remoteness
- their insularity and small size
- their adverse topographical and climatic conditions
- dependence on a limited number of local industries
- The European Commission proposed a new approach to better address the specific needs of each
 of the 9 outermost regions. <u>Latest Communication of 24 October 2017 (COM (2017) 623 final)</u>
- It identified that participation in Horizon 2020 has been so far inhibited by remoteness and the fragmentation of our research communities.
- Launched a specific call dedicated to outermost regions under Horizon 2020.

FORWARD is the only project that has been retained for funding

FORWARD Project

Project key aims:

- 1. Improve ORs' excellence in research and their innovation potential;
- Foster their participation in EU research and innovation funded projects; and
- 1. Link research activities with territorial development.

The project is a concrete opportunity for collaboration and networking among ORs institutions, representing the quadruple helix (university, business, government, and civil society)


The FORWARD H2020 project involves 24 partners from the 9 European Outermost Regions:


Project framework

Technical Work Packages

WP2 Diagnostics of OR's R&I ecosystems (NEXA, La Réunion)

- Understanding of needs and obstacles of ORs in terms of infrastructure, equipment, knowledge & skills, and networks;
- Identification of assets and opportunities for ORs;
- Definition of a joint strategy for OR R&I ecosystem performance improvement.

WP3 Thematic Work Groups (ITC, Canary Islands)

- Reinforcement of the actual and reveal the potential competitive advantages of ORs in their respective sectors or fields of expertise;
- Establishment and coordination of 8 thematic working groups, composed of experts from ORs or from other countries e.g., health, marine sciences, biodiversity, climate & energy, ICT.

WP4 Capacity building (FRCT, Azores)

- Design and implementation of tailored capacity building actions to increase skills for participation in EU projects;
- Creation of a network of ORs R&I Officers to promote and support on the long term the participation of ORs in EU Research Framework Programmes.





Technical Work Packages

WP5 Networking activities (ACIISI, Canary Islands)

- Strengthened collaboration between ORs and other research and innovation organizations in EU and Third countries;
- Organisation of mobilities among researchers and scientific/brokerage events for networking.

WP6 Connecting research and policy making (ARDITI, Madeira)

- Facilitation of dialogue between the research community and policy makers;
- Production of policy recommendations to better tackle ORs' gaps and challenges in the future Framework Programmes.



Capacity building, policy-making, and networking


